These are competitively awarded Federal Supply Schedules with fixed-unit labor rates. They are available to all federal agencies and their approved contractors through Online Ordering at: www.gsaadvantage.gov

The Dade Moeller fixed-unit hourly rates have been determined “fair and reasonable by the government.” Task Orders referencing the GSA Schedule flow directly from the requesting agency to Dade Moeller. There is no broker, no need to advertise, and no need to deal with a third party. This streamlined and simplified process reduces costs, saves time, and works well with any agency contract process (refer to FAR 8.4 for more details). The general steps to using this contract vehicle are:

1. Dade Moeller meets with the customer to discuss the work requirements.
2. The customer develops the work scope and deliverables. As needed, Dade Moeller will assist the customer in the task's definition of necessary labor resources.
3. The customer provides the work scope definition and funding authorization to its internal Contracts Office.
4. The customer's Contracts Office develops the Request For Proposal (RFP) and the selection criteria and issues an RFP.
5. The Contracts Office sends the RFP to three contractors on the Federal Supply Schedule.
6. After receiving the RFP, Dade Moeller prepares and submits a proposal (including price).
7. If selected, the customer issues Dade Moeller a Task Order.
8. Dade Moeller initiates work.
